Even after decades of their origin, these games still attract people of all age groups



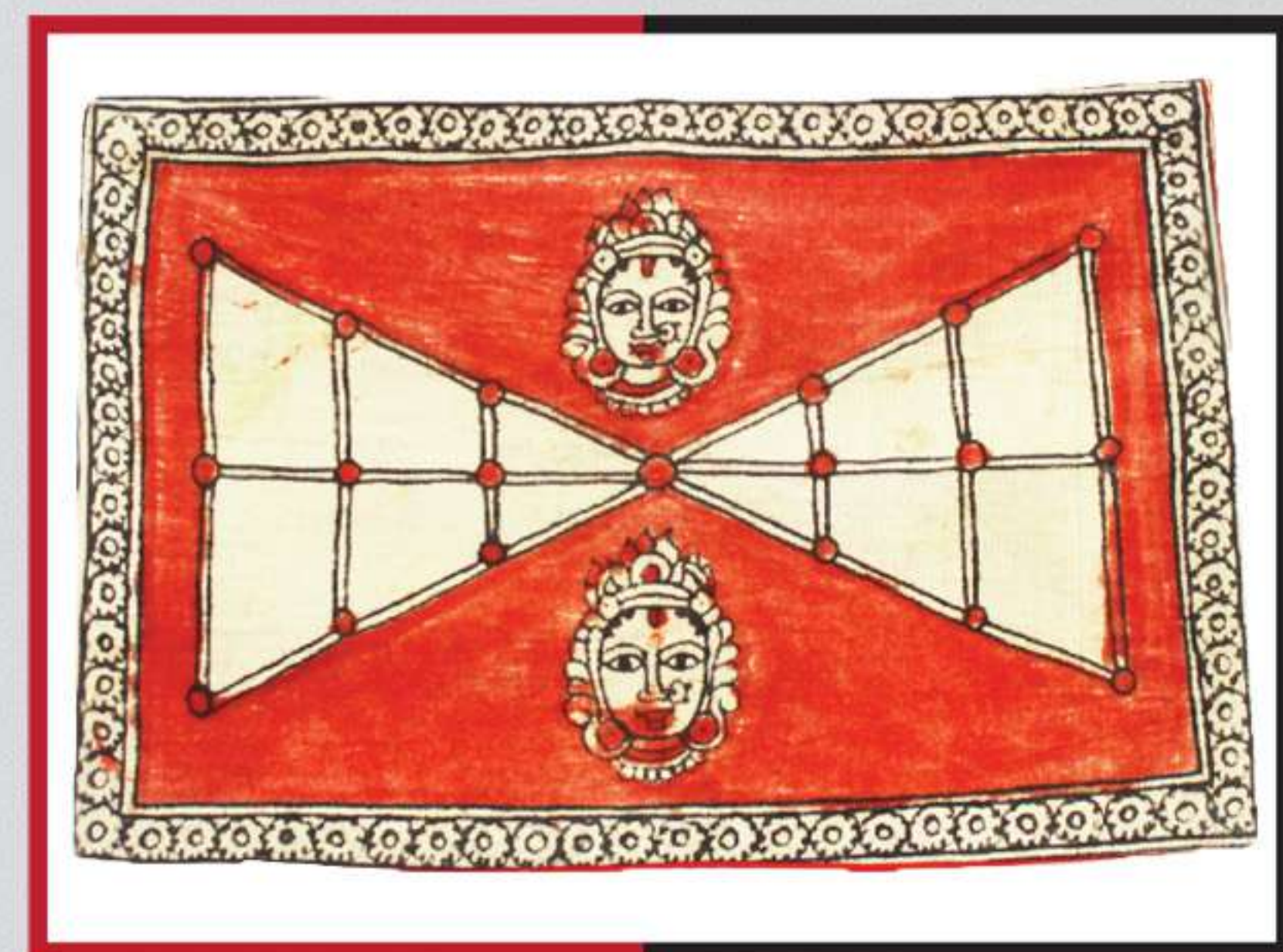
These board games are designed in "Kalamkari" art form from Andhra Pradesh



The black outline is created with charred tamarind tree sticks, followed by dipping in a solution of jaggery & rusted iron



The colouring process is done with natural dyes by a bamboo stick brush, & one by one, all 21 steps are completed

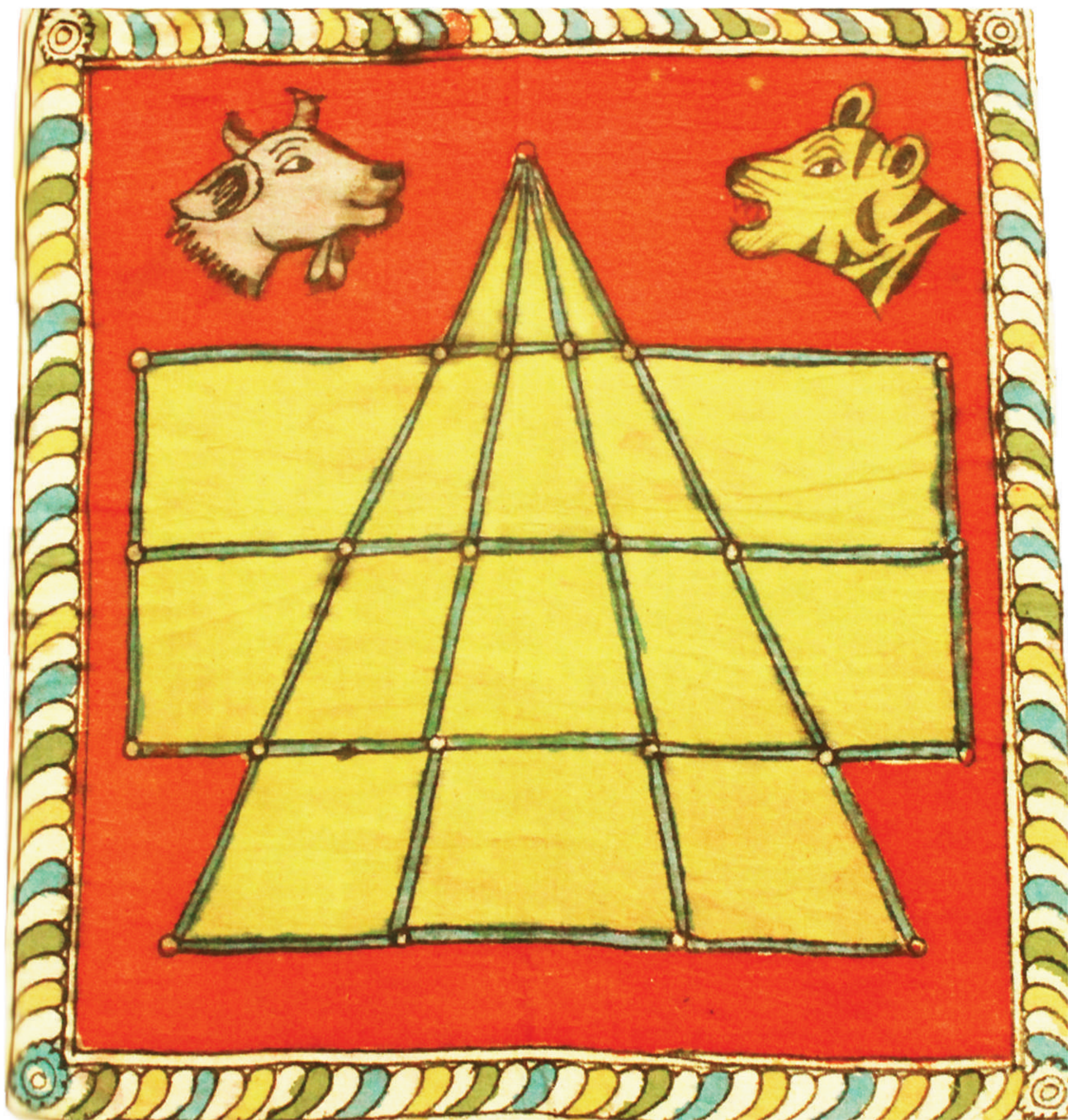

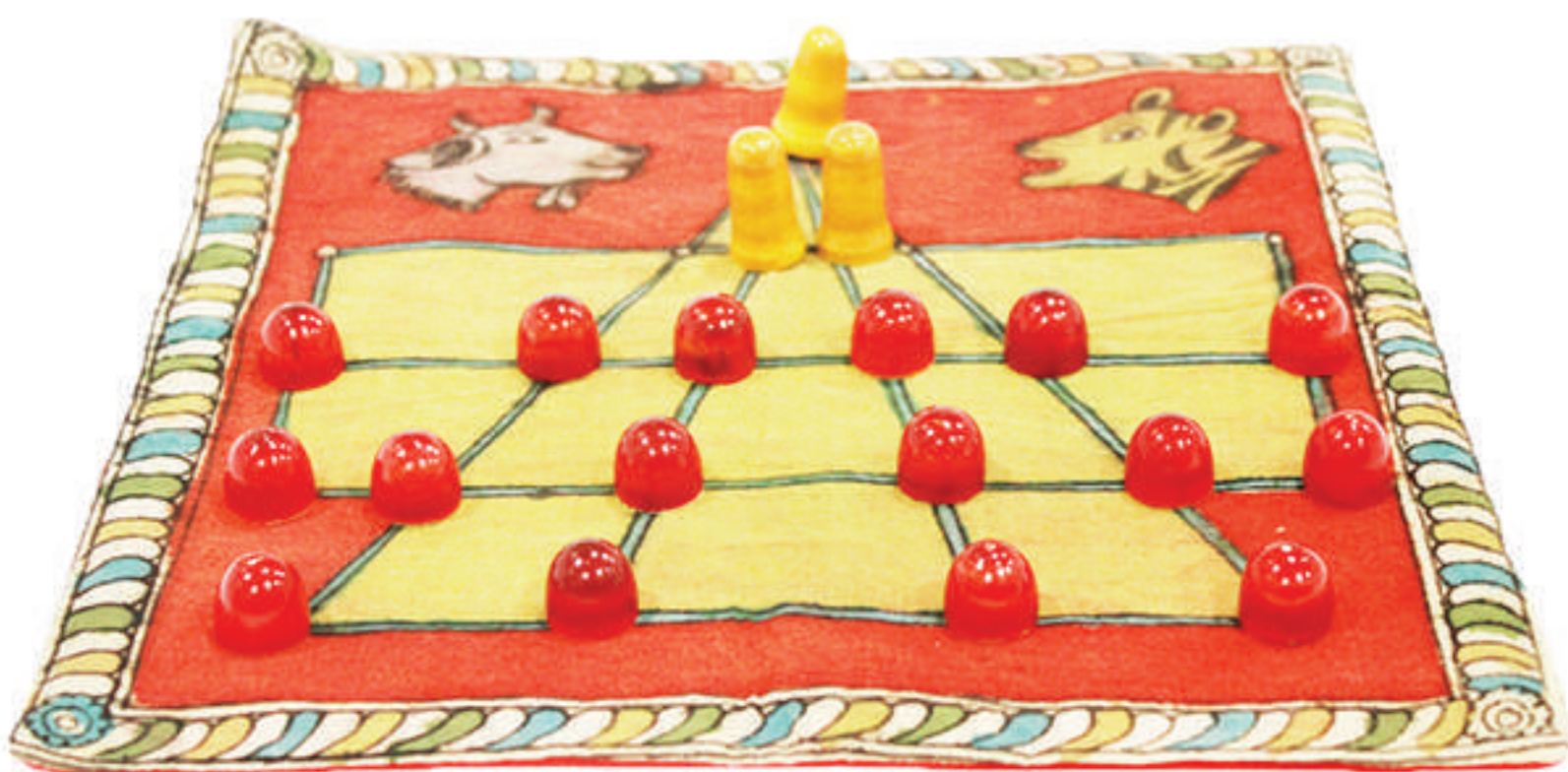

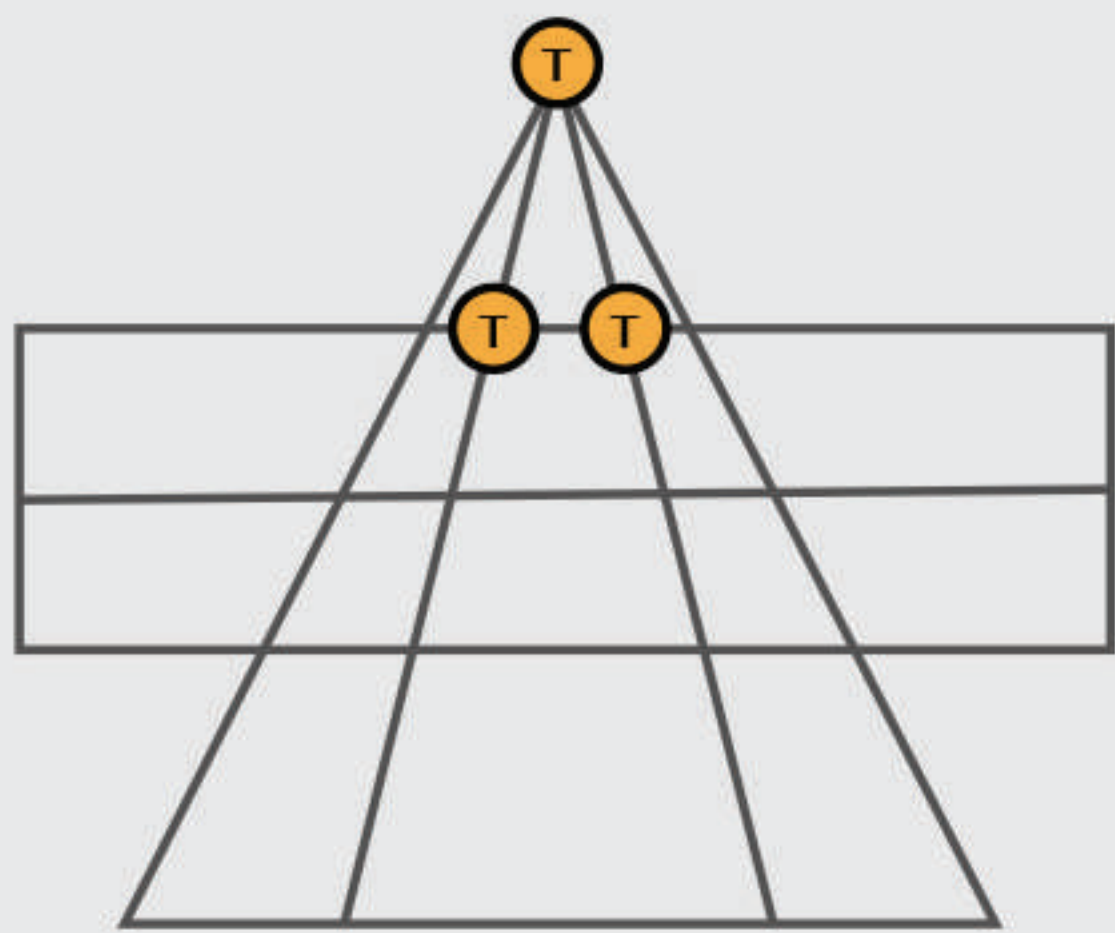
Adu Huli is an exciting hunt game played between two players.



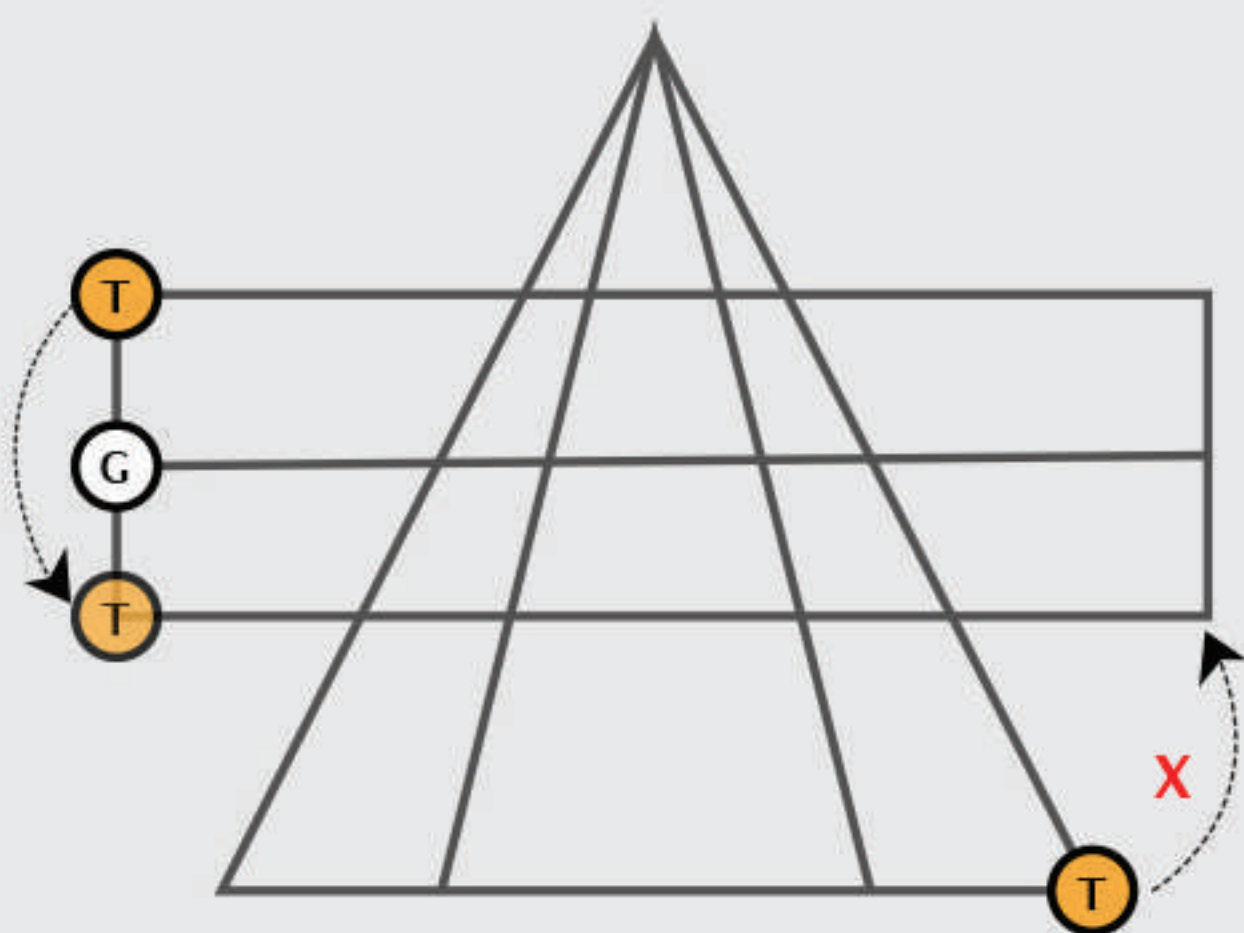

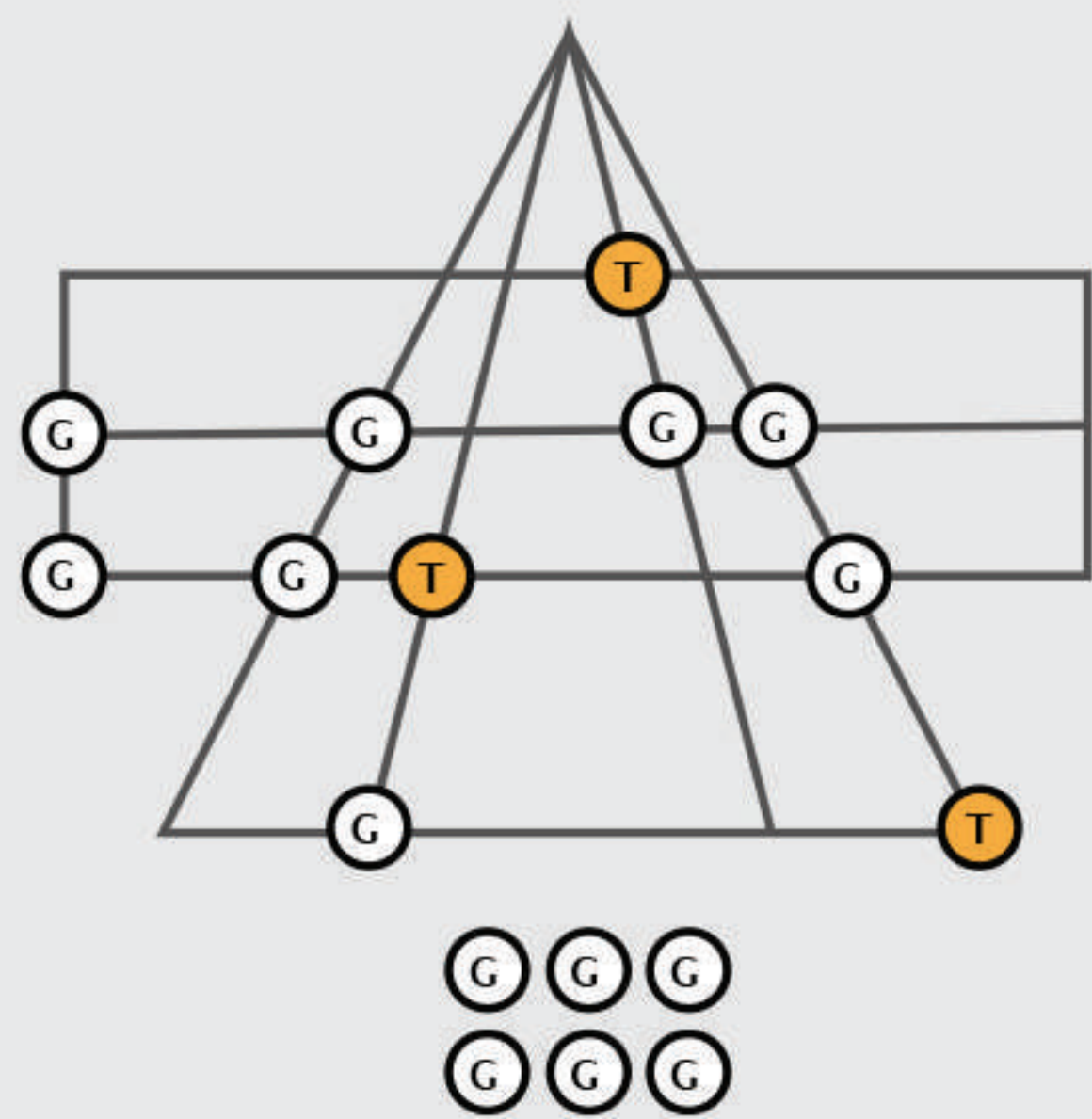

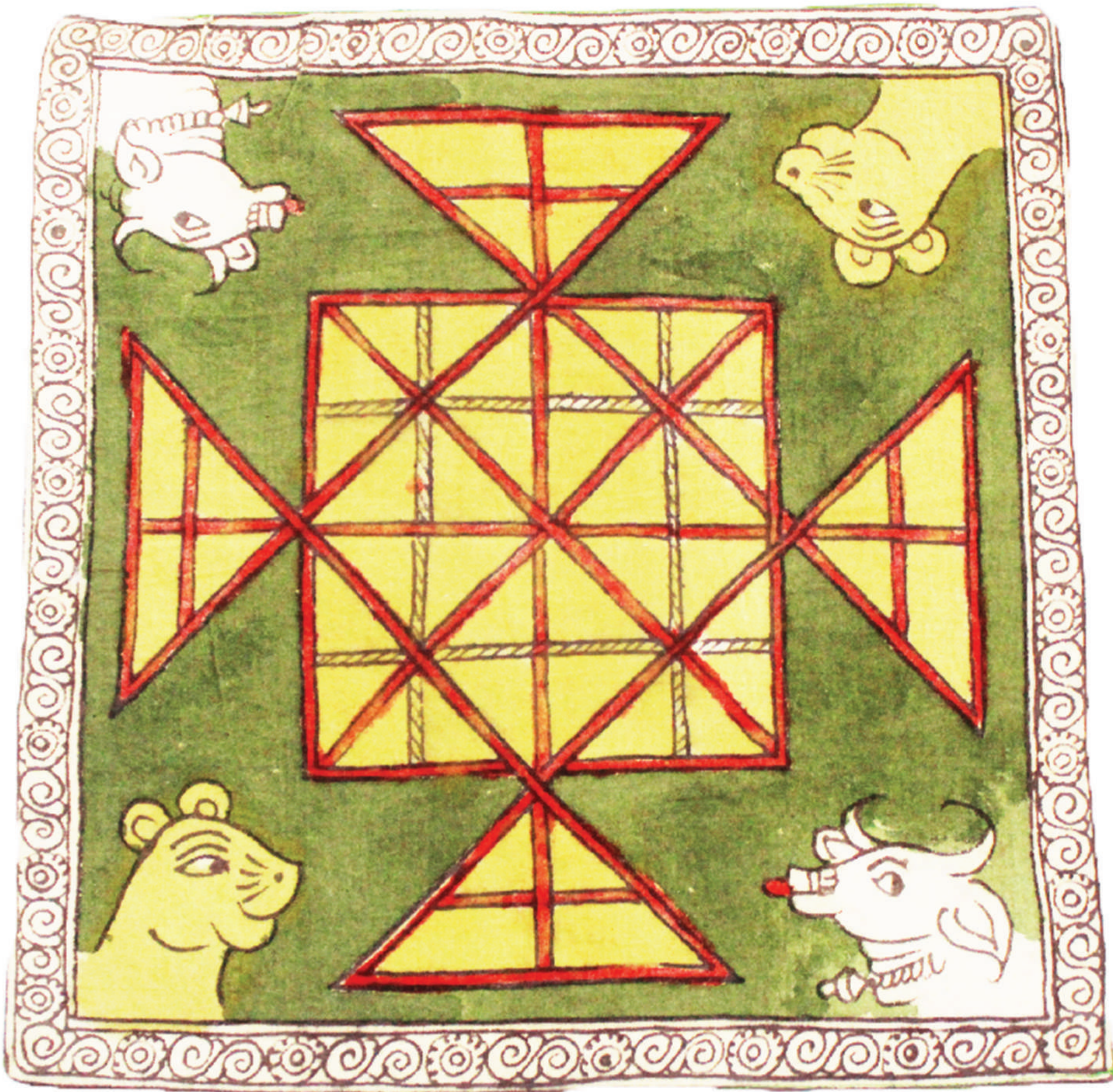


HASU CHIRATAY

Hasu Chiratay is a Hunt Game, played by two players. Hasu is Cow and Chiratay is Leopard.

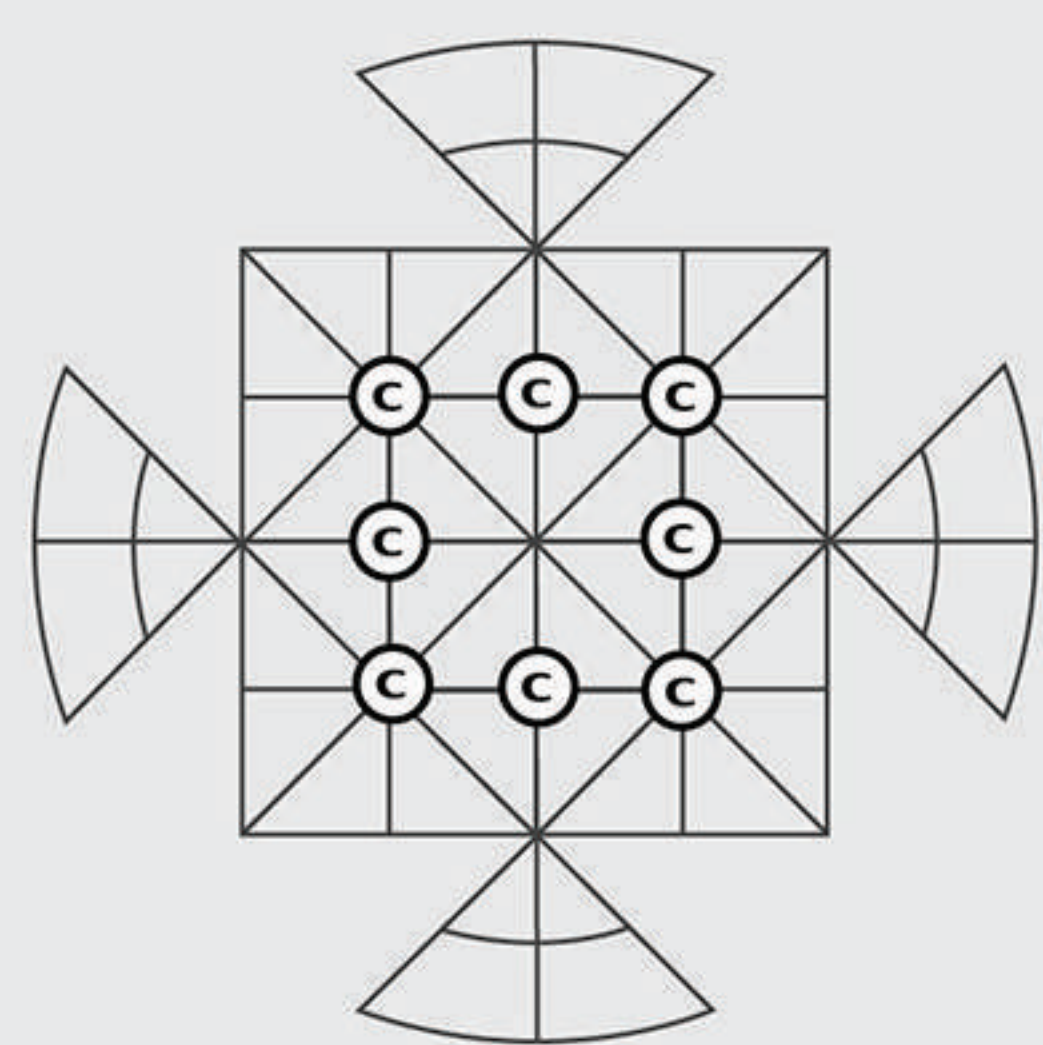


Presented in a square grid with four triangular grids touching the mid-point of each side.

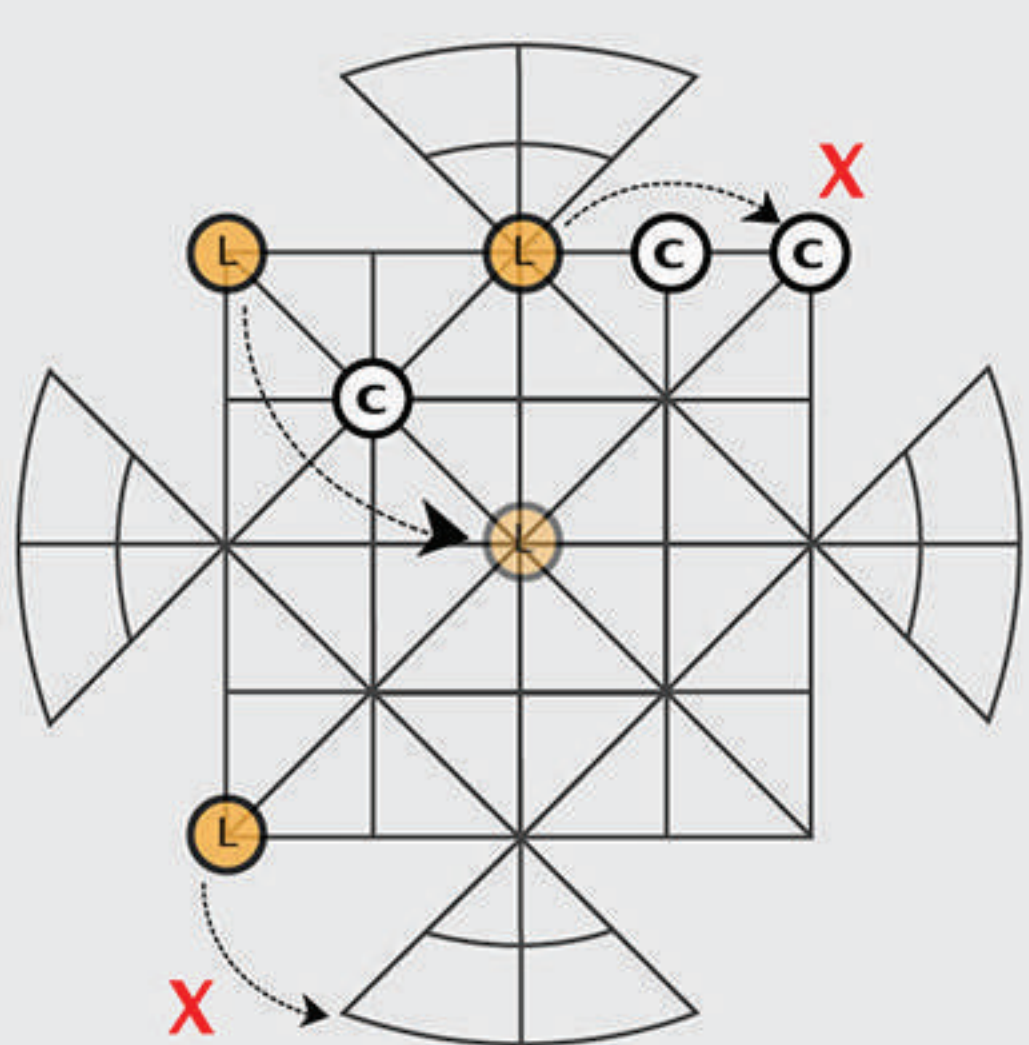


Benefits -This game enhances strategy making skill and concept of team work.

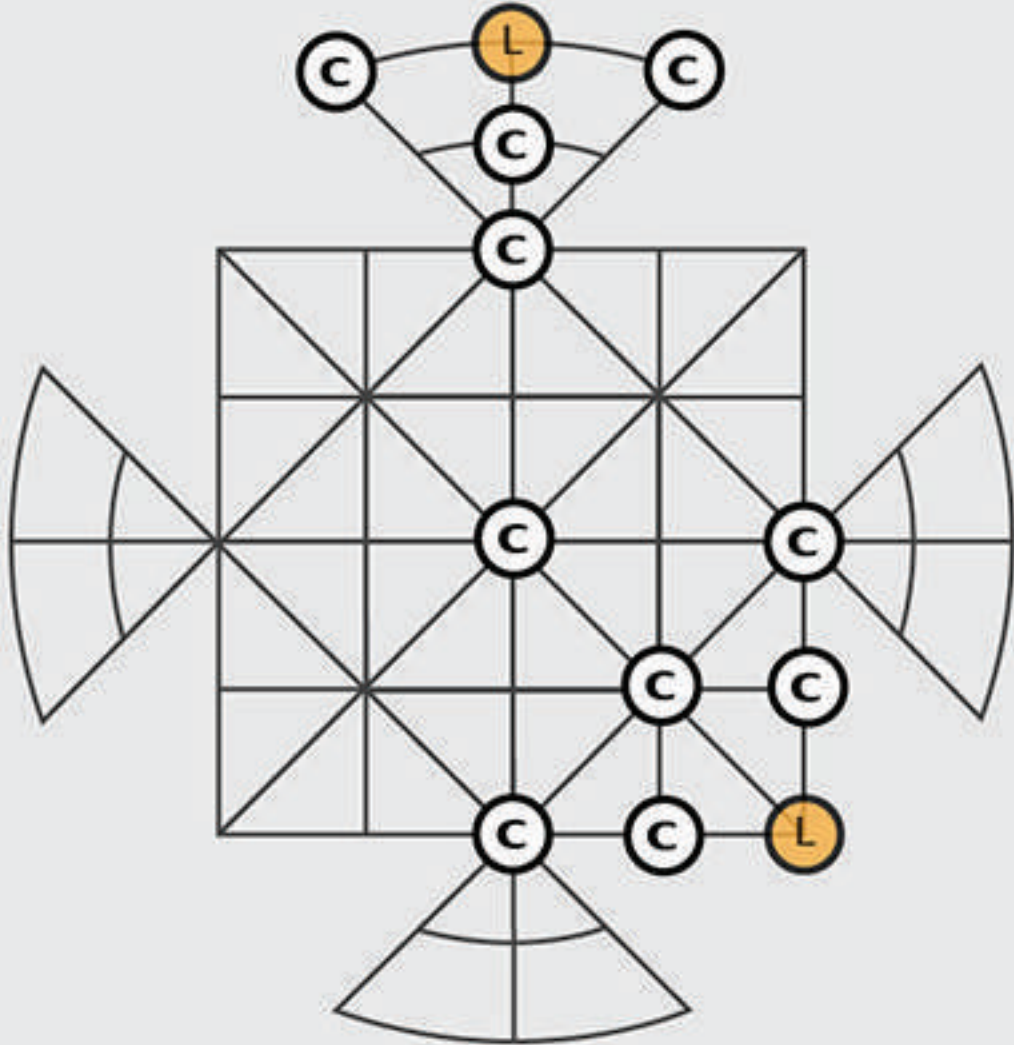

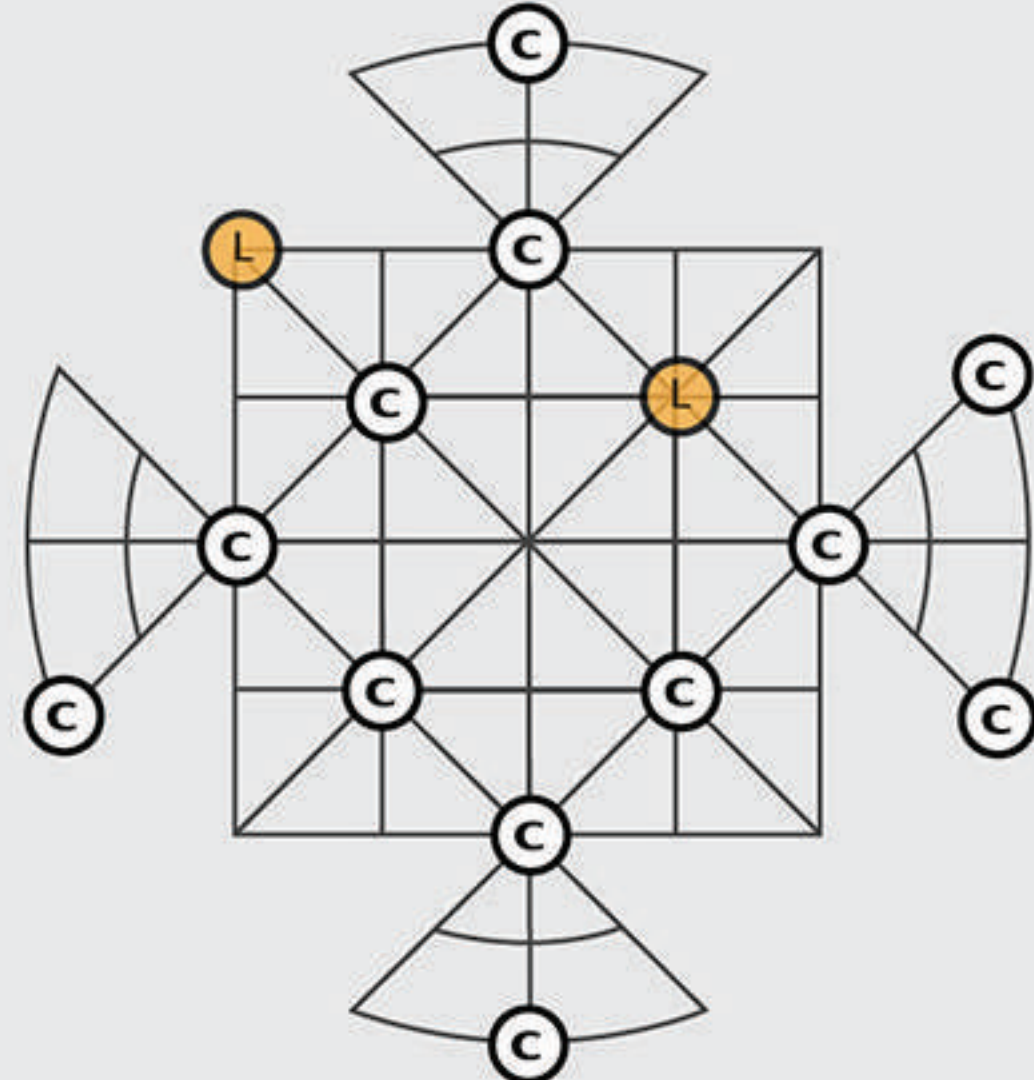

An alignment strategic game that can be played by two players.



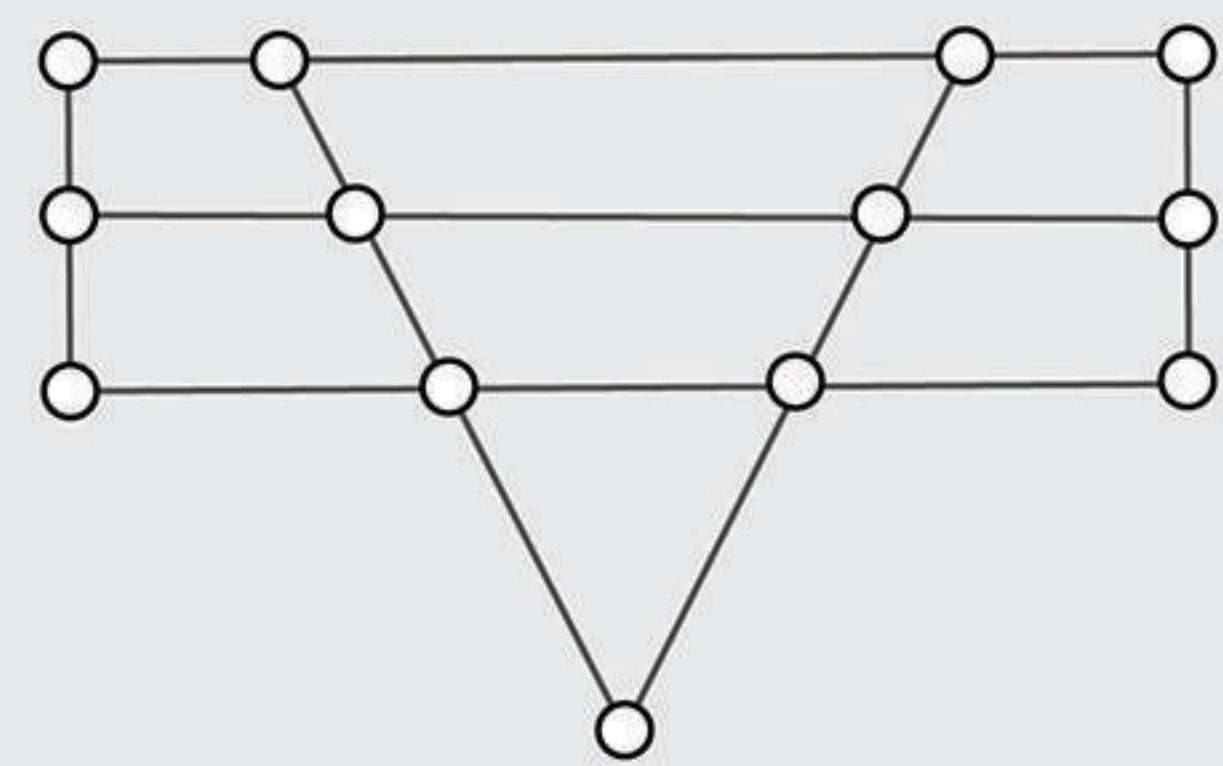
Presented in a rough resemblance of a lions face. It is won by the player who aligns all his counters in a straight line.



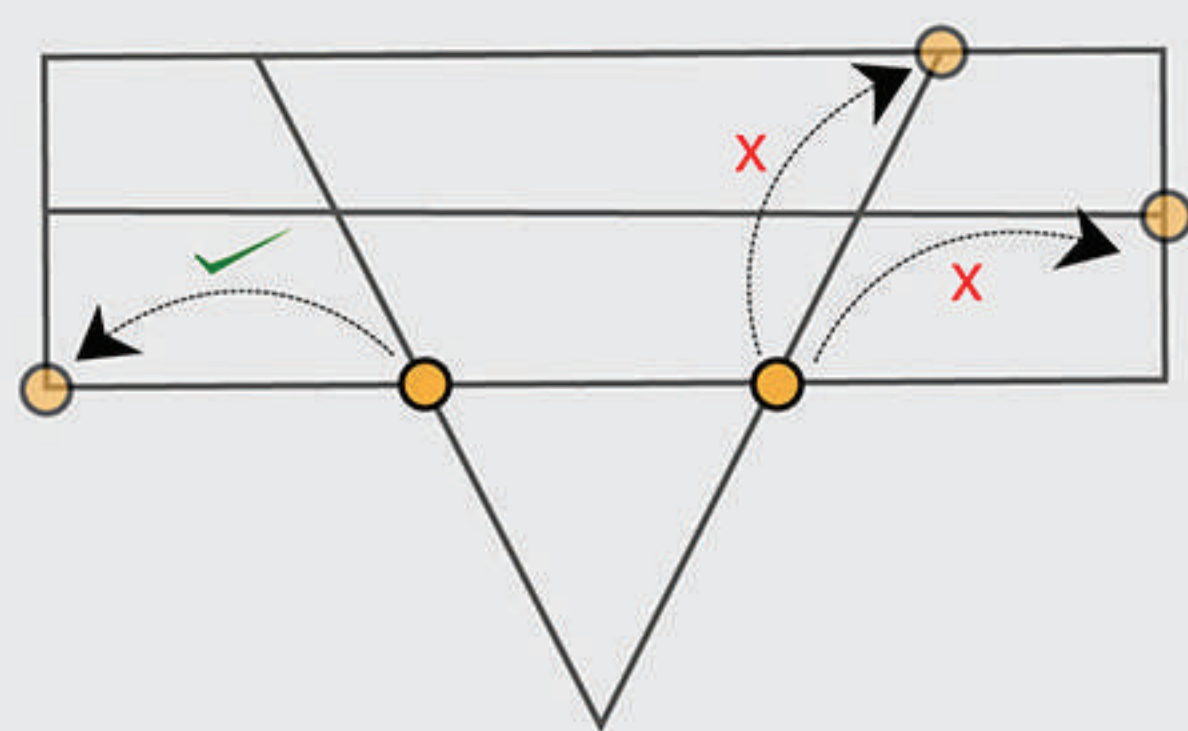

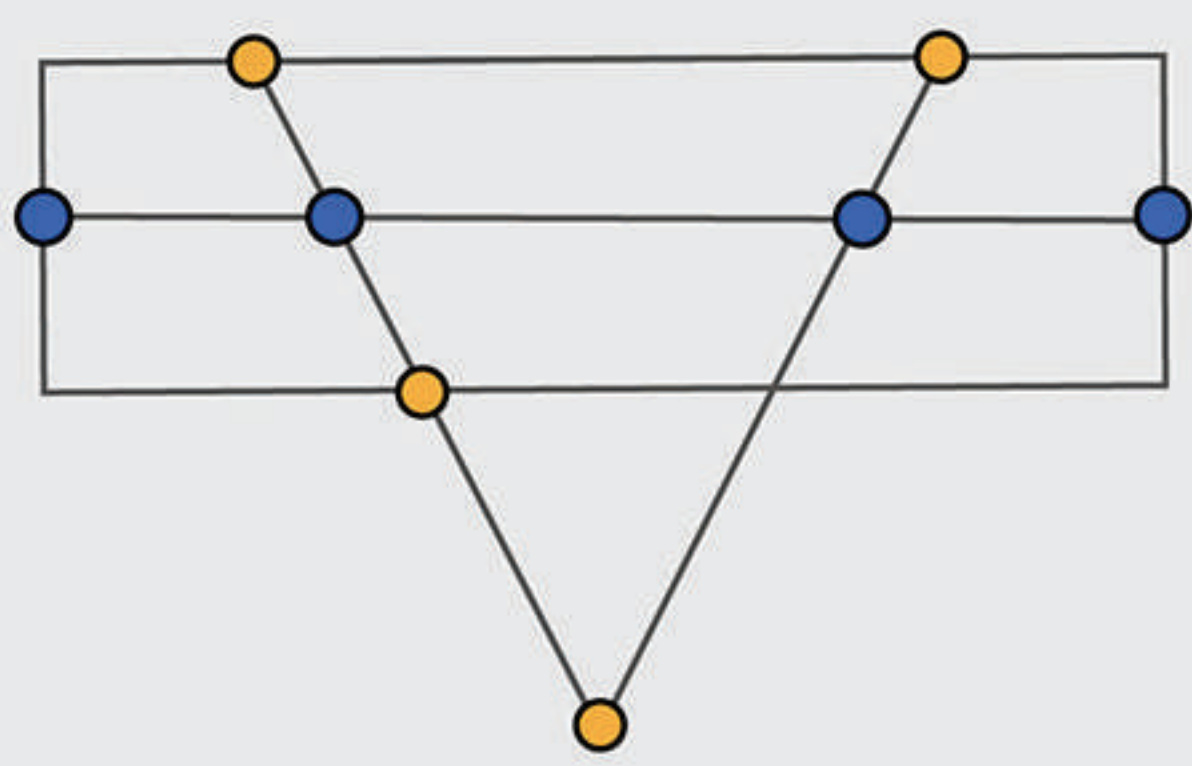

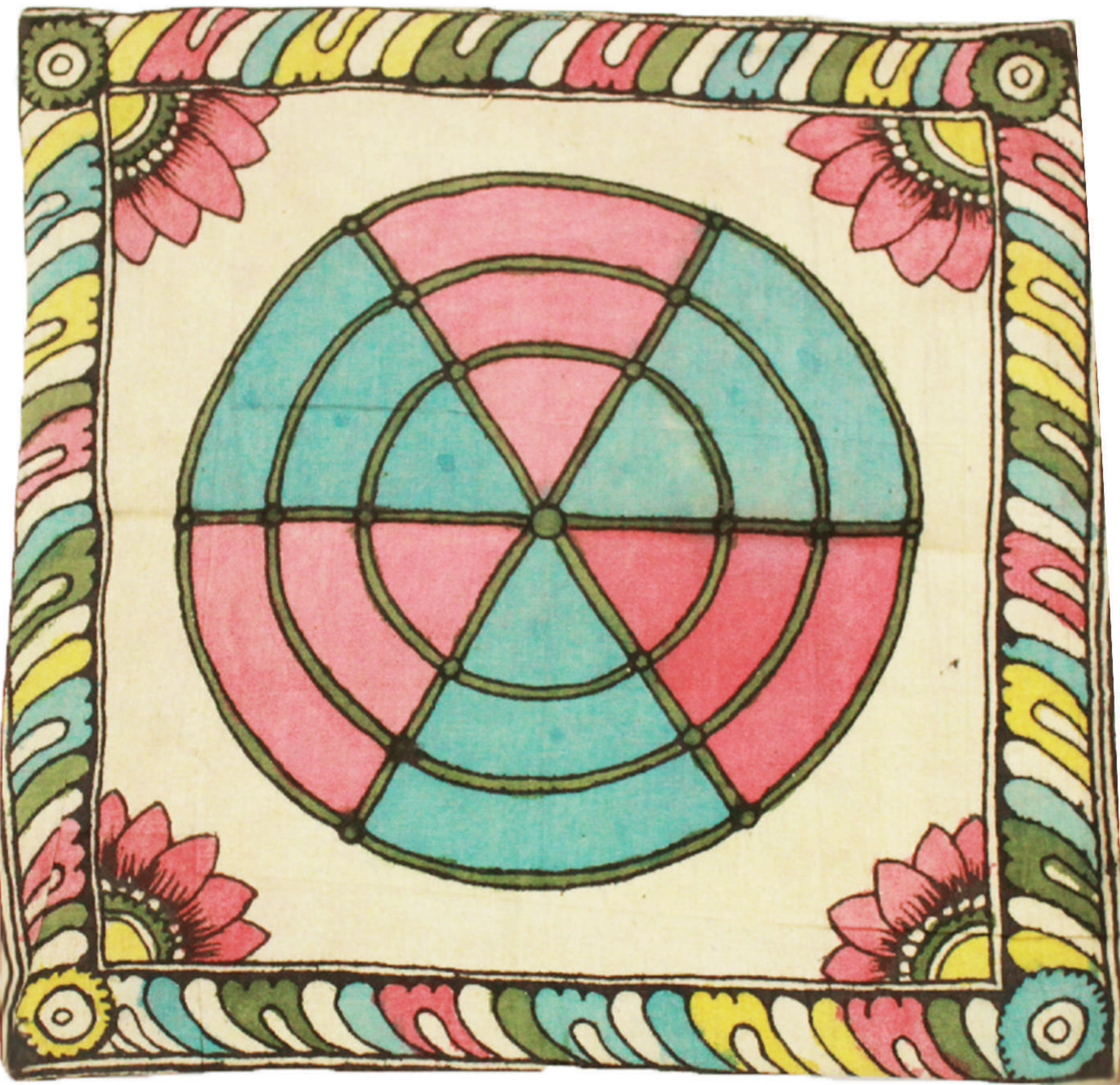

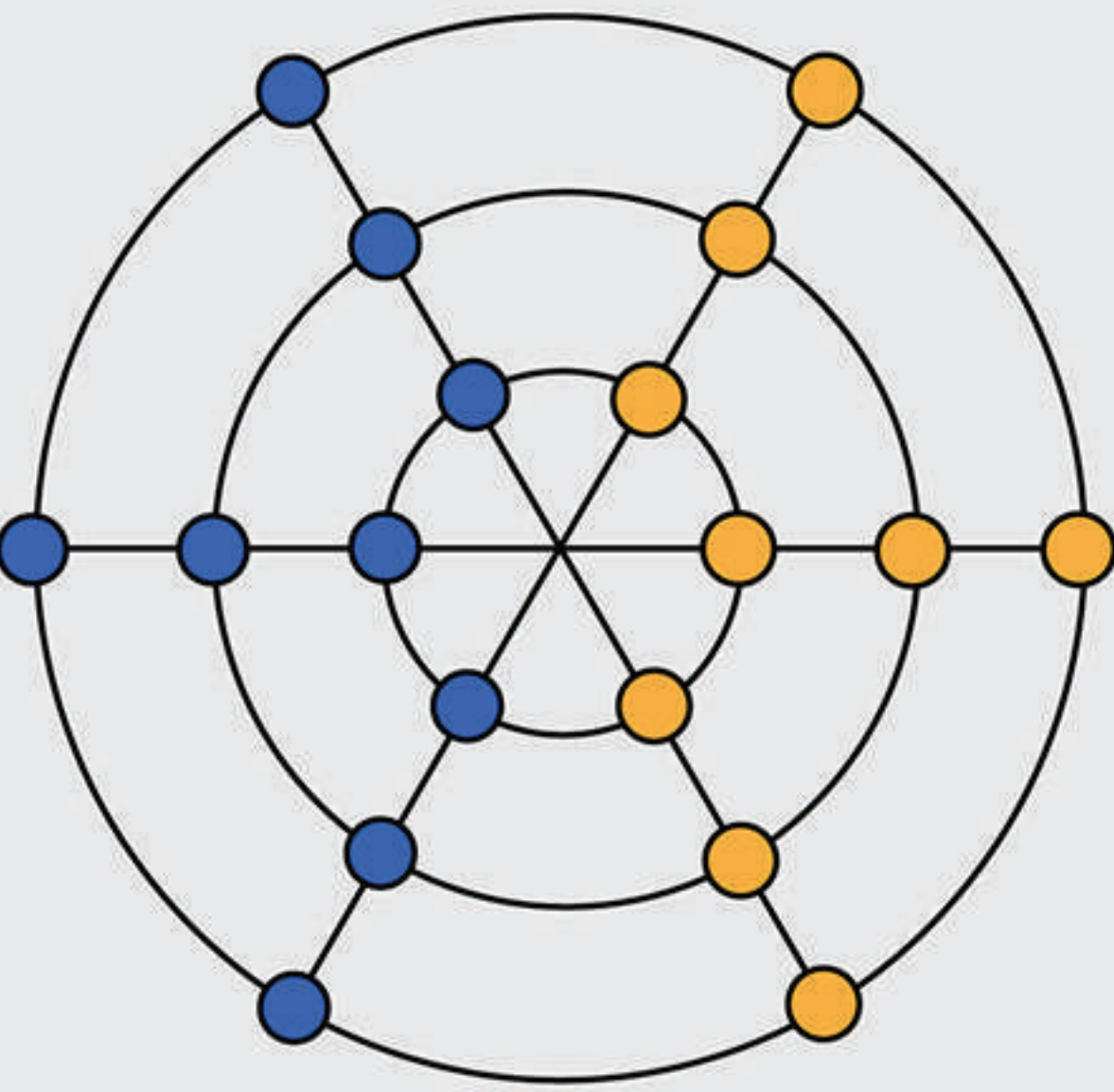


Presented in a circular grid.
Playing around the circumference, the player capturing opponent's counters win.

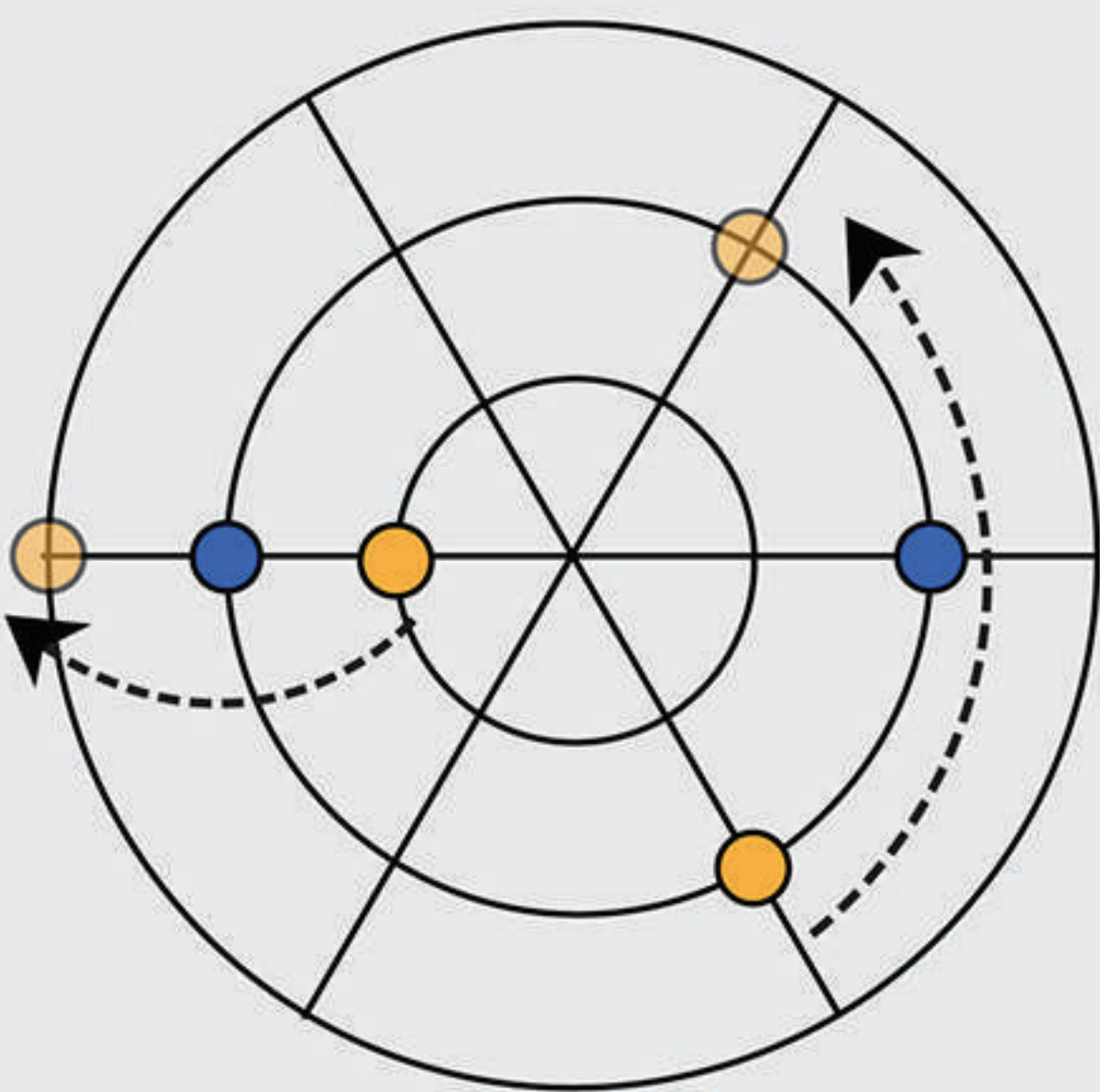

A single track race game that can be played by two players.

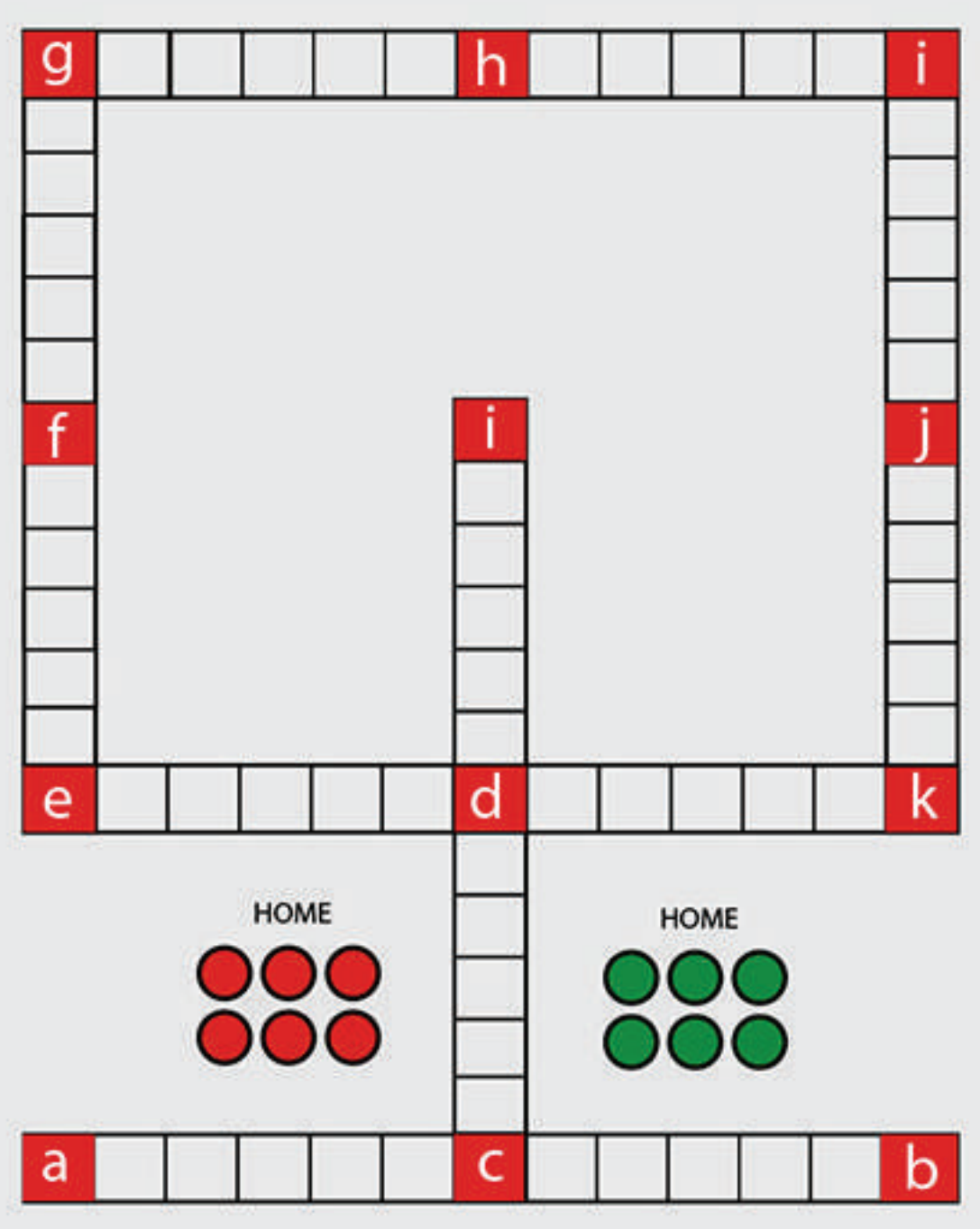


Presented in a square track grid. It is won by the player finishing the race.

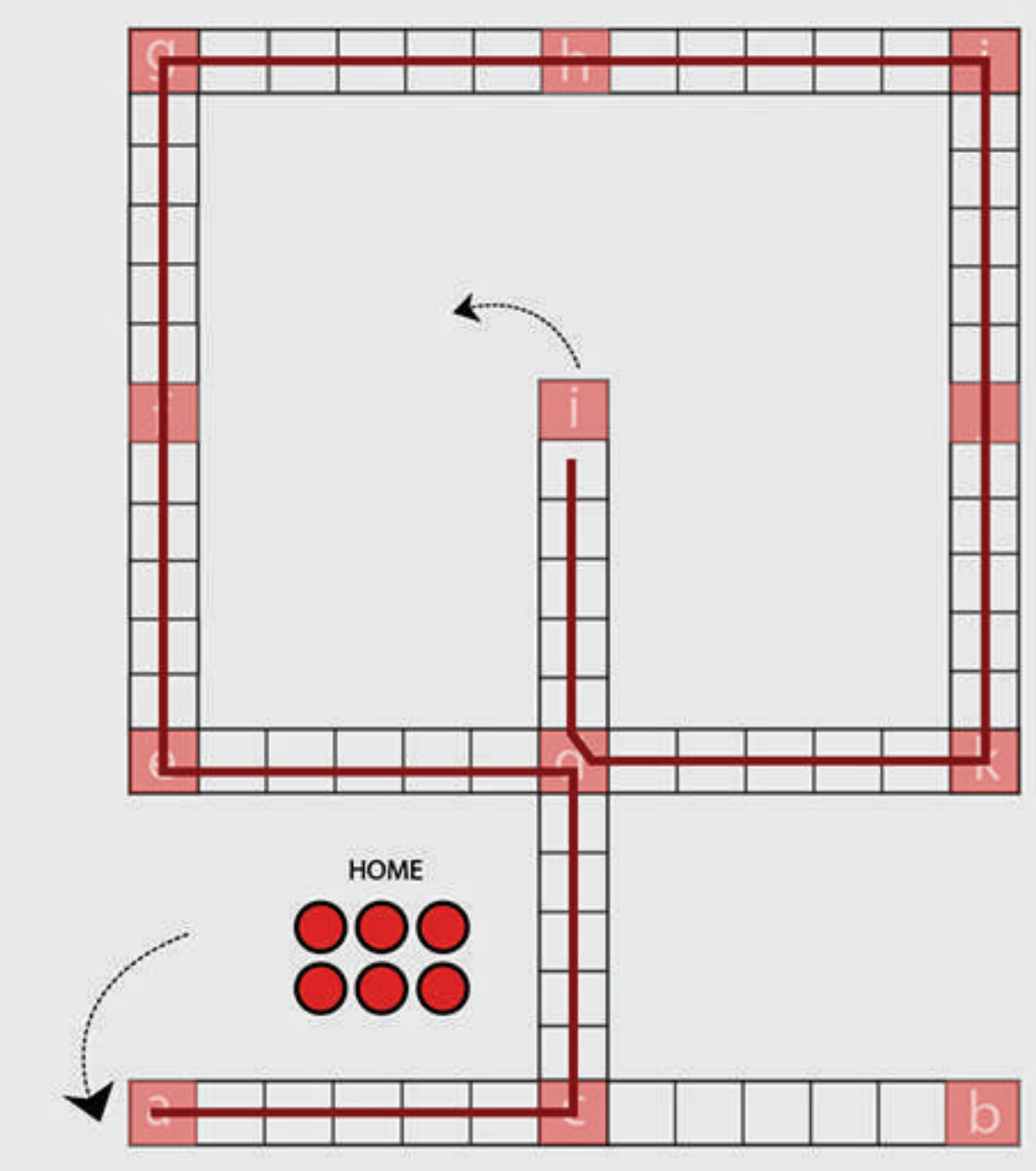

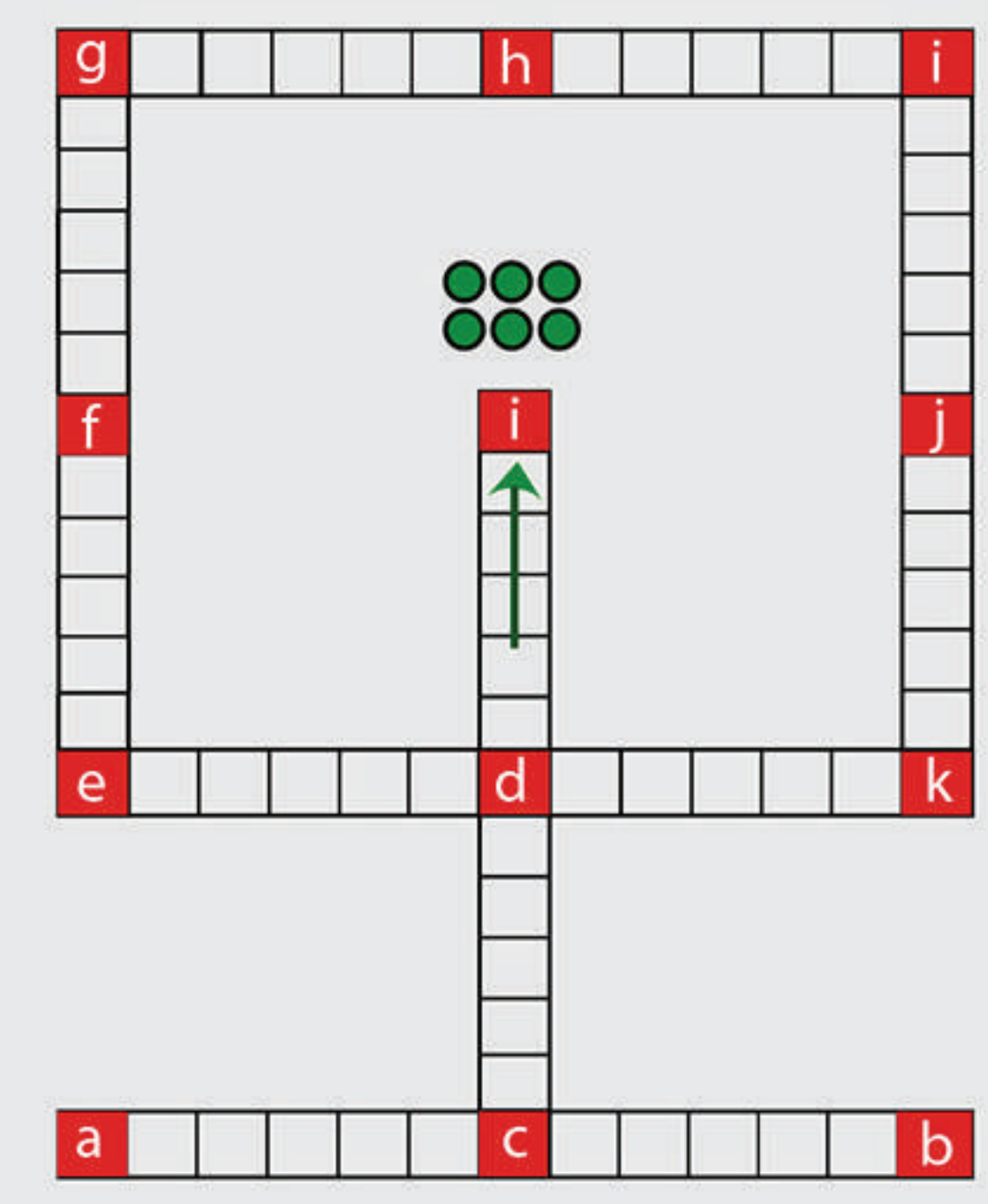

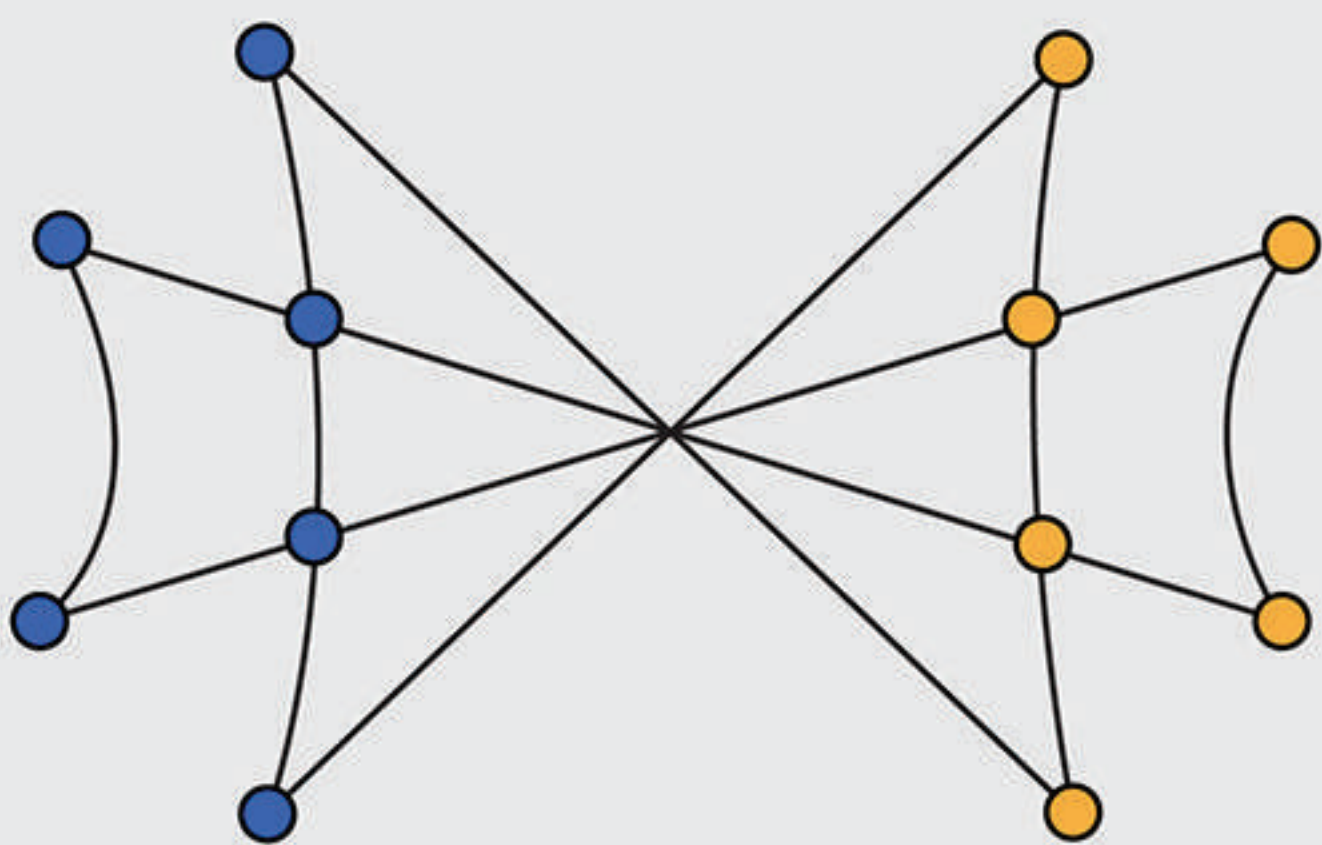


Presented in a double arrow- heads confronting each other. It is won by capturing all the counters of the opponent.

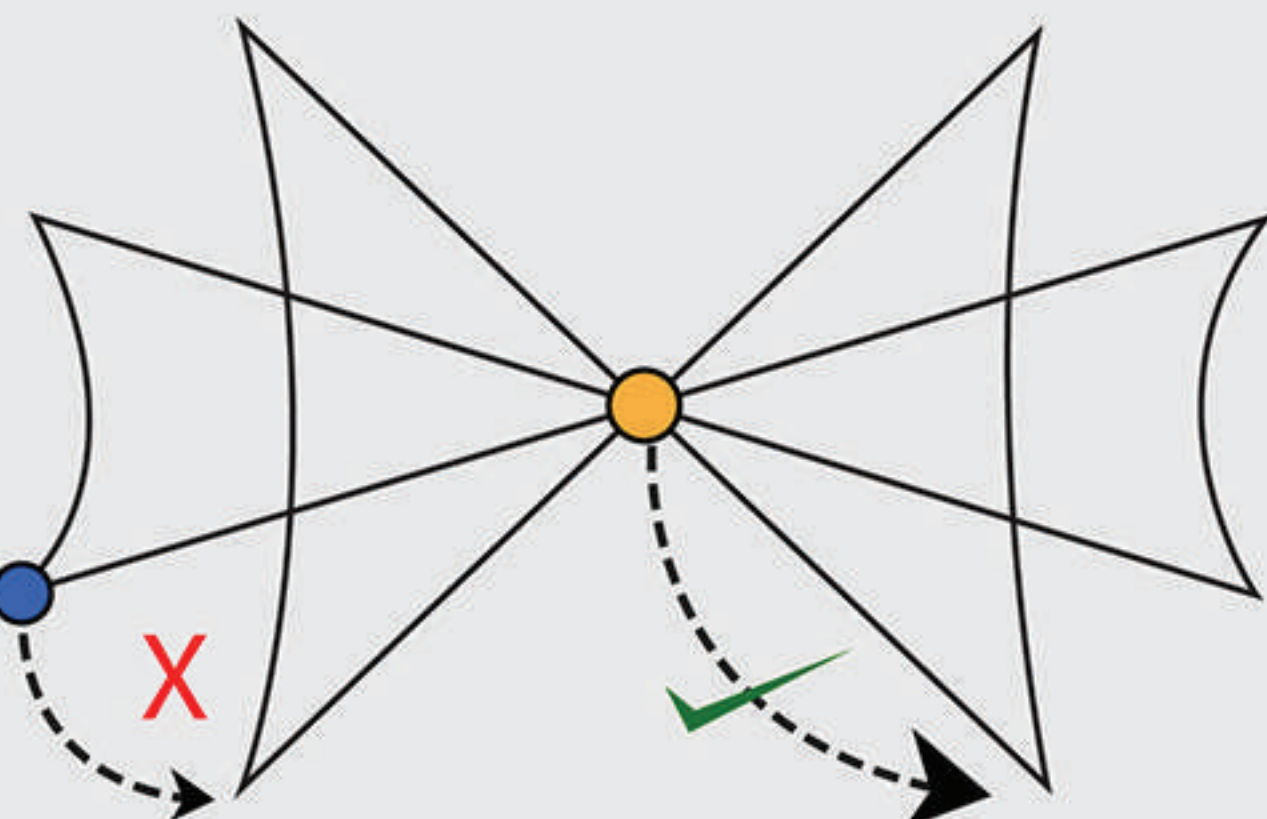
